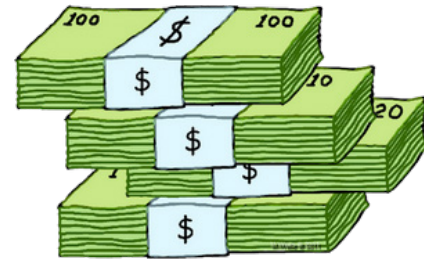

All About Coins

A **PENNY** is worth 1 cent.



A **NICKEL** is worth 5 cents.



A **DIME** is worth 10 cents.



A **QUARTER** is worth 25 cents.

Scotty spent all day in his doggie kitchen making delicious treats for his other doggie friends. He made three different treats: lemon biscuits, caramel bones and strawberry shortcake bites. After Scotty was finished baking, he set up a table outside his doggie house to sell his treats. All his friends came over to purchase his delicious creations. At the end of the day, he had sold them all! Scotty counted his money, and he made \$15.

Scotty put \$5 in each of his three jars he kept in his doggie house. One jar was for spending, so that Scotty could buy the things he needs. The second jar was for saving, so that Scotty always had extra money in case of emergencies. The third jar was for sharing, so that Scotty could help others.

3. Scotty needs to buy his friend, Paul the Poodle, a birthday present. Which jar should Scotty take the money from? Circle this jar in **BLUE**.

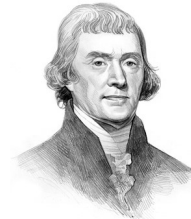

Faces of the Coins



George Washington was the 1st President of the United States, serving from 1789 until 1797. He was an American Founding Father who led the Continental Army during the Revolutionary War and oversaw the group that drafted the United States Constitution.



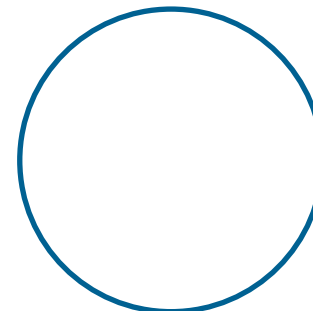
Thomas Jefferson was the 3rd U.S. President, serving from 1801 until 1809. He was an American Founding Father who was the main author of the Declaration of Independence.



Abraham Lincoln was the 16th U.S. President, serving from 1861 until 1865. He led the country through the Civil War and got rid of slavery.



Franklin D. Roosevelt was the 32nd President, serving from 1933 until 1945. He won four elections—the most of any president—and led the country during the Great Depression and World War II.
